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What to Expect

A Guide On Next Steps After the Death of a Loved One

After the death of a family member or friend, there are many details to take care of. It is our goal to help make this difficult time as simple as possible, to provide you with peace of mind and to answer questions about what to expect throughout the cremation process.

Once your loved one is in our care, our team will reach out to you to discuss next steps and schedule an arrangement meeting to review all of your options, finalize planning and documentation.

Cremation Process and Final Resting Place

Death Certificate: In order to put your loved one's financial affairs in order, it is important to obtain a certified death certificate. You may need a certified or photo copy of the death certificate to access financial accounts, life insurance, property, retirement, Department of Motor Vehicles, trusts, income tax, probate court, Social Security, veterans benefits, employment compensation, and other records. We will guide you in this process, which includes:

- **Vital Statistics information:**

- *There are key pieces of information needed to complete this legal document.*
- *Ensuring that this information is accurate is essential. We will ask you questions and verify information such as;*
 - *Your loved one's full legal name, birthdate, place of residence, race, education, occupation, and social security number.*
 - *Parent's full names, mother's maiden name.*
- *Next of Kin information.*
- *It is critically important that you double check this information for accuracy as amendments are costly to your family and delay the receipt of the corrected death certificate.*

- *We will submit the death certificate information to the Medical Provider for their signature on cause of death and will file with the Office of Vital Records.*

- **Third-party fees charged by the local government** *for certified death certificates and any additional copies may apply. We will order your certified death certificates for you, or you may order them directly from the county clerk of vital records division.*

Cremation Permit and Fee: Once the death certificate has been signed and filed by the state or county, the permit is issued to proceed with the cremation process. Depending on the state, some coroners or medical examiners may charge a fee. The permit, along with the required legal documents from the next of kin or authorized representative, allows us to schedule the cremation.

Once the permit is finalized and all necessary family documents have been obtained, the cremation will be scheduled. The process of obtaining all necessary documents and completing the cremation can take up to 15 business days. Should there be any delays, we are committed to keeping you informed and working diligently to complete the cremation process in a timely manner.

Payment for our services, the cremation process, Death Certificates, State fees, and cremation permit, where applicable, are due at the time of the arrangement conference, and prior to the cremation.

Social Security and Veterans Benefits: Your funeral arranger will guide you through the process of notifying the Social Security Administration to obtain available benefits regarding your loved one's death. If your loved one is a veteran, we will assist in helping with entitled burial and cremation benefits.

Identification Verification Process: From the moment your loved one is in our care, until we release their ashes back to you, a strict identification verification process is in place. We use a Positive Identification System that exceeds state mandates to secure the integrity of your loved one. Your loved one is identified with a specialized ID band and titanium ID tag as required by each individual state. In addition, as part of this process, we may ask you for a recent photograph.



Final Resting Place: There are many options for a final resting place of your loved one's ashes:

- **Home:** *One of the most common choices for families is bringing your loved one's ashes home.*
- **Interment:** *Ashes may be placed in a permanent location, such as a wall niche, an urn garden, or a cemetery. By contacting your cemetery of choice, you will have a better understanding of what they require. We can then help you choose an urn or container that meets their specific requirements.*
- **Veterans cemetery:** *Veterans burial benefits can help veterans and their family members plan for a burial in a state or national veteran's cemetery. Your funeral arranger will guide you through the process about veteran's death benefits.*
- **Traveling:**
 - **Interstate:** *When traveling within the United States, you must have the burial transit permit or record of cremation along with the urn at all times. If traveling by plane, a suitable container (plastic or wood) is required to carry on your loved one's ashes. Please call your airline ahead of time to gather specific details and restrictions.*
 - **Abroad/Overseas:** *Please reach out to the country's consulate of your destination for proper traveling requirements if you choose to send or take your loved one's ashes overseas.*
- **Shipping:** *If you desire to have your loved one's ashes mailed to you within the United States, the U.S. Postal Service is the only legal option for shipping. We will provide you with tracking information and a signature will be required at the time of delivery. We are unable to ship internationally.*

The Living Urn



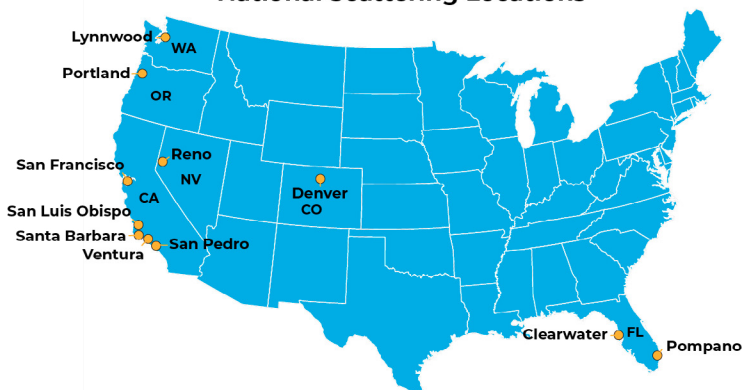

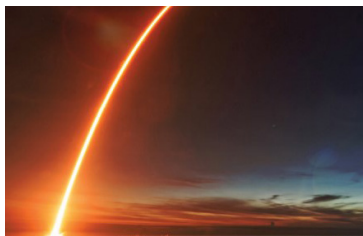
Sea scatterings take place in designated areas throughout San Francisco Bay, including locations near the Golden Gate Bridge.

Celestis Memorial Space Flights

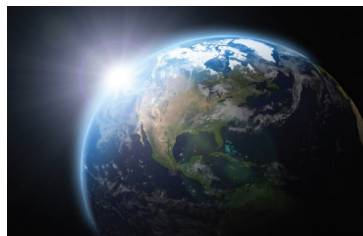

Voyager Spaceflight

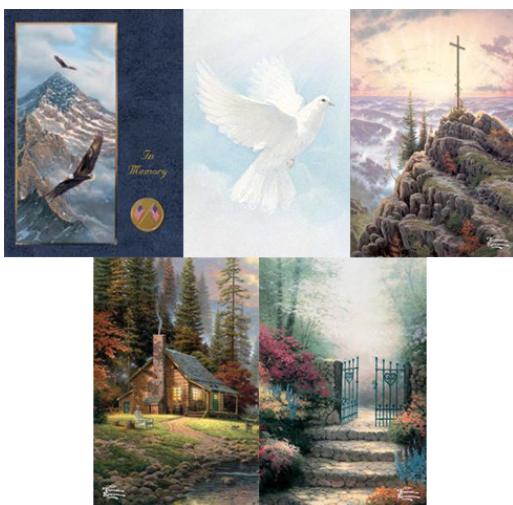
The Voyager Spaceflight is a true mission of exploration, sending a personalized flight capsule carrying ashes on a permanent celestial journey, well beyond the moon.

Online Obituary

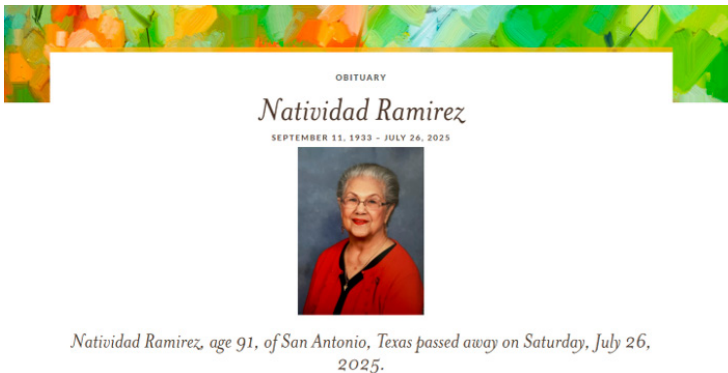
We are proud to offer you an online obituary free of charge. Once you have completed the documentation with us, a simple online obituary will be automatically posted.
